Beautiful Camp Tuscarora is located in Four Oaks, NC. Camp Tuscarora has shelters in every campsite and plenty of open spaces. The camp features several different activity areas such as shooting sports, a BMX track, a skatepark, and more. When you come to Camp Tuscarora be sure to stop by the Four Oaks Trading Post. The Camp is laid out with all of your main buildings toward the front and campsites surrounding. Tuscarora recently had shower houses replaced, and have only been operating since this summer. Their main highlight is increased privacy. The Camp is preparing for Conclave in April and those of us at 296 are very excited about hosting and wish to see everyone there.



CAMP FEATURE: CAMP BODDIE

Camp Boddie is located on the East Carolina Scout Reservation in Blounts Creek, NC. Boddie boasts a wide variety of seasonal and year-round activities. The Waterfront Merit Badge area allows Scouts to pilot sailboats, canoes, kayaks and motorboats. Scouts can also enjoy watersports activities such as tubing and jet-skiing thanks to its location on the shores of the Pamlico River. The PotashCorp Ecology Lodge is one of the most extensive nature areas in the Southern Region. Visitors can interact with living animal exhibits, participate in science and nature experiments or take a stroll through a cypress swamp on the Wolff Nature Trail. The Climbing Area is set up with a climbing tower, zip line, high COPE course and low COPE course. Grab a drink in our recently redesigned Trading Post and enjoy a game of horseshoes or corn hole.
