In preparation for Conclave it is important to take note of the following items that will be imperative to a smooth arrival and departure from Raven Knob.

- All delegates and especially those in Klahican, Croatan, and Tsoiotsi Tsogalii lodges should plan to arrive at Raven Knob prior to 7:30 pm on Friday. The road going to campsites of the aforementioned lodges will close for the opening show prior to 8:00 pm. Vehicles will not be let through to reach their campsites until after 9:30 pm. Similar restrictions will be in place on Saturday and Sunday during shows.
- Everyone that attends and wishes to participate in COPE, climbing, and shooting activities **MUST** have completed the Outdoor Release Form prior to Conclave, which can be found <u>here</u>.

Lodge Feature: Nayawin RaR Lodge

We here at Nayawin RaR have had a very active schedule recently with a multitude of projects, workdays, events, and new programs for all brothers to participate in. This past summer, Nayawin RaR began a new "OA Every Day" program during our summer camp sessions at Camp Tuscarora. Brothers on camp staff worked together to implement Order of the Arrow programs into our schedule at least once every day for our Arrowmen campers to enjoy. These ranged from gift buckets given to arriving troops, Brotherhood Conversions, and an OA ice cream social and trivia night! We have also held officer elections and training, as we sent a contingent to the Carolina Indian Seminar to learn about native ceremonies and traditions. Recently at Camp Tuscarora the area was hard-hit by Hurricane Matthew, resulting in damage and widespread flooding in the area. Our Arrowmen collectively performed over 1,200 hours of service during our Fall Fellowship to assist in the cleanup efforts. Camp Tuscarora has also benefited from cheerful service in other projects, such as a new Scoutcraft program area which will be open this summer, and new entrances to certain areas of the camp property.
